**GOOD FRIDAY CHILDREN'S LITURGY** – There will Stations of the Cross with craft activities, singing and hot cross buns at S. Saviour's for children at 10am on Good Friday. Everyone Welcome. Thank you to Vicki Pepper, to Felicity van der Linde and everyone who will be contributing to this liturgy.

THE PASCHAL TRIDUUM - Fr Toby writes: "These three sacred days, beginning with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Thursday and culminating in our celebration of Our Lord's Resurrection, are the most holy days of the church year. They will be marked in this parish with rich liturgy, scripture, music and prayer. Coming to the church for the Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and the beautiful Easter Vigil is something all Christians should try to do and is a wonderful way of deepening our faith. Please try to make coming to these celebrations a priority and invite others too."

**CLOCKS CHANGE** - Don't forget that the clocks go forward 1 hour at 1am next Sunday morning signalling the start of British Summer Time - and lighter evenings. Don't be late for church.
