LENT begins on Wednesday. Lent is a holy season of renewal, as we consciously seek to return to God and to deepen our relationship with the Lord through spiritual disciplines, including prayer, fasting and almsgiving. If you would like any advice about how you intend to keep Lent, please speak with the clergy.

SHROVE TUESDAY CONFESSIONS – Start Lent well by making your confession. The clergy will be very happy to guide you in preparing for your confession if you would like any help. Fr Toby will be available to hear confessions on Shrove Tuesday from 8.15am to 9.15am at S. Saviour's, from 2pm to 3pm at S. Luke's, and from 5.15pm to 6.30pm at S. Mark's. Please speak to Fr Toby or Fr Adam if you would like to make your confession at any time during Lent by appointment.

ASH WEDNESDAY – On Ash Wednesday we come to Mass and receive the imposition of ashes as a sign of our desire for repentance.

It will be a wonderful day of celebration: Mass will be celebrated at 11am at which the holy oils for the year will be blessed and the clergy will renew their ordination promises; this will be followed by a buffet lunch, catechesis and benediction.
